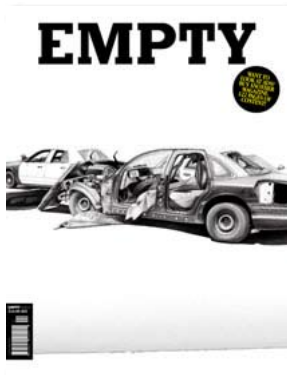


Atomic Ranch

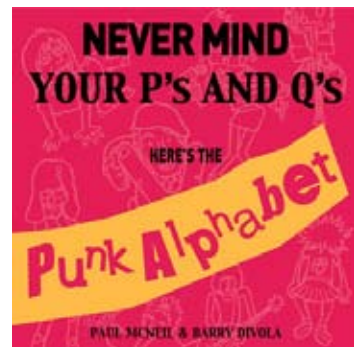
The Peeps
